Development Matters 3&4 Yr Olds - Nursery

Begin to make sense of their own life-story and family's history.

Development Matters - Reception

Comment on images of familiar situations in the past.

Compare and contrast characters from stories, including figures from the past.

Early Learning Goal - Understanding the World - Past & Present

Talk about the lives of people around them and their roles in society. Know some similarities and differences between things in the past and now, drawing on their experiences and what has been read in class.

· Understand the past through settings, characters and events encountered in books read in class and storytelling.

How is it taught at Tadpole?

Stories linked to topics - Transport in the past, christmas in the past, celebrations, toys - comparisons of old and new weaved into most topics and themes

Everyday experiences comparing to the past

Curiosity Cube - pictures/objects from the past to provoke questions and comparisons

Technology in the past and now - linked to home corner and everyday technology uses

Significant people in the past - Amelia Earhart, Queen, Neil Amstrong,

Variety of stories from the past across topics eg Mrs
