Draw 3 or 4 different types of shells (or use the ones on the next slide). Can you create your own repeated pattern?

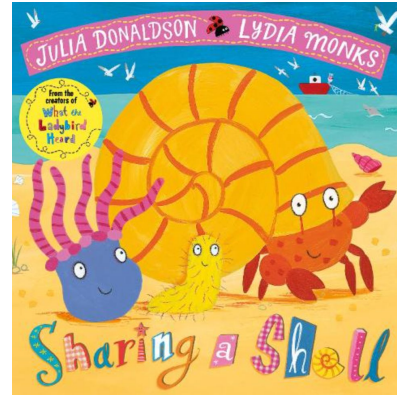
