From Monday 17th June, all Year Reception pupils should enter the School through the double gates by the Drop Zone, and not through the gate by the Office, as there will be some work taking place on the outside area where they would usually enter. Some of our YR pupils already do this, and they will do so when they are in Y1 and so this will be good practice for them. Members of the YR Team will be on the Drop Zone gate to welcome the children and to take any messages from parents.

At the end of the day, for a week (we'll let you know if it's any longer than this) please collect your YR child from the wooden gate by the YR outside area within the main playground - again, staff will be around to direct you on Monday. You can still use the same gate that you would usually to access this space from 3.25pm.
